



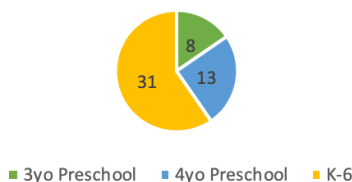

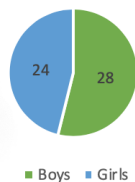


School Profile

Gender Profile





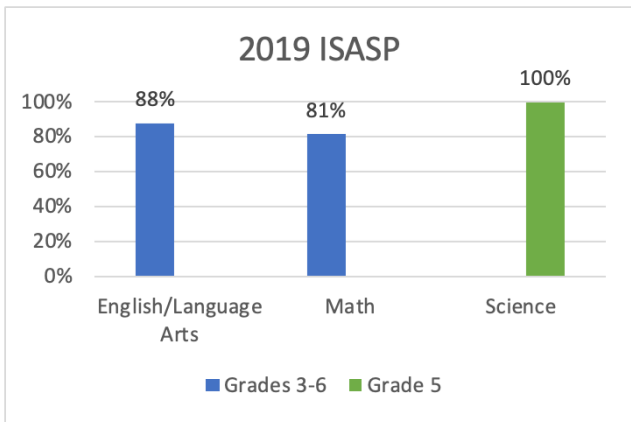

Student Assessment



Standardized tests, such as the new Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress, provide a snapshot of a student's performance on a specific test on a certain day. These tests are taken once per year and 100% of La Salle students in grades 3-6 take the ISASP. Standardized tests, alone, present an incomplete picture. It is useful to consider these tests along with other assessments to gain a more complete picture of a student's learning.

La Salle Catholic School's goal for our state required comprehensive school improvement plan stated: "By the year 2019, 90% of students in grades 2 through 6 will be at or above the benchmark level on the FAST CBMreading (CBMR)." We continue to work on the goal.

The Measures of Academic Progress or MAP tests are norm-referenced assessments La Salle Catholic School students take three times during the school year.
