Facilities Rental: The La Salle Catholic School gym and cafeteria are available for rent. Mississippi Valley Regional Blood Center offers the Life Savings School Grant program. The grant offers \$250 if a minimum of 20 units is collected. Funds cannot go directly to the school or sponsor group. Funds are granted to the approved payee (third-party vendor) in which the supplies, events and/or equipment are being purchased. Funds can be used for, but not limited to, payment for books, classroom supplies and/or equipment, technology, and educational field trips. Funds must be put towards an approved educational expense that benefits classroom curriculum and students directly.

Halloween at La Salle: Halloween will look a little different this year. We won't be able to have parties in the same way that we have in the past. Teachers will share their plans with the families in their classrooms. Students in four-year-old preschool will celebrate on Wednesday, October 28. Students in three-year-old preschool and kindergarten through sixth grade will celebrate Halloween on Friday, October 30. A change the students will likely enjoy is that the costume parade will be expanded to include students in the older grades. We will have a costume parade on Friday, October 30 at 3:15. If the weather cooperates, we will hold it outside in the parking area by the gym. If the weather is unpleasant, we will invite families to social distance themselves around the gym and students will parade around the gym. Students will be dismissed and can leave with their families immediately following the costume parade. Costumes should not include weapons of any kind. We prefer to keep Halloween light-hearted and encourage students to avoid wearing gruesome costumes at school.

Red Ribbon Week: As the nation's largest and oldest drug prevention campaign, Red Ribbon Week® reaches over 80 million people each year throughout the United States. The Red Ribbon serves as a catalyst to mobilize communities to educate youth and encourage participation in drug prevention activities. Students at La Salle will learn about making healthy choices and staying drug free.
