Dear Parents/Guardians,

March 16, 2020

Our original plan was to have school open today, March 16 and March 17, however due to how the virus is spreading in Wisconsin, and now having a confirmed case in a neighboring county, we will **not** have school with students or childcare on Tuesday, March 17<sup>th</sup> and from there we will be transitioning to alternate learning platforms until at least April 6, 2020.

At Holy Spirit Catholic School, classes and childcare **will remain open for the remainder of the day** on Monday, March 16<sup>th</sup>. There will be no face-to-face classes from March 17 until at least April 6, as students will be learning from the safety of their homes.

**Monday, March 16:** School and childcare will remain open for the remainder of the day. The teachers will meet after school to discuss a plan for home based and e-learning.

**Tuesday, March 17:** Teachers will report to Holy Spirit and prepare for home based learning and e-learning activities. Parents/Guardians will be able to pick up materials at school from 10:00 am-3:00 pm. Parents will be able to pick up materials in your child's classroom and ask questions. No home based or e-learning learning requirements.

**Wednesday March 18:** Teacher preparation for home based and e-learning lesson plans. No home based or e-learning learning requirements.

**Thursday, March 19:** Home based and e-learning learning activities begin

All school activities are postponed beginning March 17<sup>th</sup> until further notice, until at least April 6, 2020. This includes sporting practices and events, field trips, school family activities, concerts, etc. We will be diligent in following through with all recommendations made by our local, state, and national health departments.
