

Holy Spirit Parish Community Comeback Plan General Information (revised 7/6/20):

1. Care will be taken that our facility is cleaned and maintained properly after each Mass.
2. The celebration of Sunday Mass will be offered four times per weekend starting with the Sunday Vigil celebrations on Saturdays at 4:30pm in Kimberly and continuing with Mass on Sunday at 7:30 am in Darboy, 9:30 am in Kimberly, and 11:30 am in Kimberly.
3. Catholics wishing to attend Mass will need to print a “free ticket” from our Parish website.
 - a. Tickets will be available on a first come, first serve basis and everyone (adults and children of any age-including infants and toddlers) will be required to have a ticket.
 - b. Those who do not have access to a computer may reserve their spot at Mass by calling Jeanne Konwal at (920) 851-0494 starting Monday June 8, 2020 at 9:00 am
4. The obligation to attend Sunday Mass is dispensed through Phase II, duration TBD.
5. All those as defined by the health department as more vulnerable (i.e. those with compromised immune systems, those with underlying health conditions, those who are especially anxious about being in a large group, etc.) are encouraged to stay at home.
6. The livestreaming of our Masses will be at 7:30 am Mass on Sunday at Darboy and will be available on our website.
7. As a sign of Christian Charity, we ask that everyone wear a mask to church.

For the Celebration of Mass:

1. Those attending Mass will be asked to enter through the front doors of the Church. All other entryways to the Church will be locked for your safety.
2. Please plan on arriving 15-30 minutes early for Mass so that everyone can be seated and ready prior to Mass beginning. When the doors are closed that means we are at capacity.
3. Hospitality Ministers of Holy Spirit will greet you and offer you directions on where to register and show your ticket. You will then be directed to your seat.
4. Hand sanitizer will be provided prior to entering church, or you can bring your own to use before the reception of Holy Communion. Bishop Ricken has asked that communion will only be distributed under one form and is to be received only in the hand. Social distancing requirements of a minimum of 6 feet between people will need to be maintained while in line for Communion.
5. Social distancing of a minimum of 6 feet between people not living in the same household must be followed while on Church property.
6. Please note that there will be no song books in the pews.
7. There is a secure lockbox in the entry way of the church for those who wish to make a monetary contribution to the parish. A basket will also be made available in the entry way of Church for you to make your donation as you enter the church. There will be no collection in the pews. All parish members are strongly encouraged to sign up online to give electronically or to continue to mail or drop off your contributions to the parish office.

After Mass:

1. Dismissal and the proper exiting procedures will be given by the presider.
2. Gathering in the church at any time is discouraged.
3. Scrip will not be sold after Mass.
4. Attendees are encouraged to wash their hands as soon as possible after Mass. Hand sanitizer should be used when exiting church. It is also suggested that attendees should wash their clothes following the celebration of Mass.

There is no predetermined timeline for how long these restrictions will be in place. We will do our best to communicate with you as things change.
