3. NWEA Update- Measure of Academic Performance for grades k-8

- a. Math focus this year

4. Marathon Updates

- a. We raised \$19,600 and we exceeded our goal of \$18,000
- b. We used Venmo and it was a great tool for fundraising we also used connect now giving
- c. Plan to use these funds for student enrichment
 - i. We are not sure what that looks like
 - ii. Hoping to still fit field trips in later in the year if possible
 - iii. Funds will definitely be used for student enrichment
- d. We are lucky that 100% stays with the students and isn't used for operational budgets which is unique to OLP.
- e. Cora suggested putting together a list to send out to new families of all of our fundraisers for the year.

- f. We finally got a refund for last year's cancelled trip. Last year's 8th grade students will get an opportunity to get a refund of their fundraising or donate it back to the current 8th grade class for their possible trip to Washington DC.
 - g. The funds from Marathon are divided up equally by the number of students in each class.
 - h. Paul is open to any ideas and contacts for enrichment activities
- 5. Virtual Tour
 - a. We had a company come in after school to create a 360 degree virtual tour.
 - b. This will help us promote the school while we are not able to do in person tours.
 - c. It should be published within the next month.
- 6. OLP Stoplight Updates
 - a. We have made some changes to the stop light on who should stay home for school and for how long
 - b. The stop light is located on the COVID page of the school website
 - c. The most significant change was allowing for a negative COVID test if you are having some COVID like symptoms
 - d. Negative tests do not work if you have had close contact or exposure or you have COVID you must quarantine for 14 days
