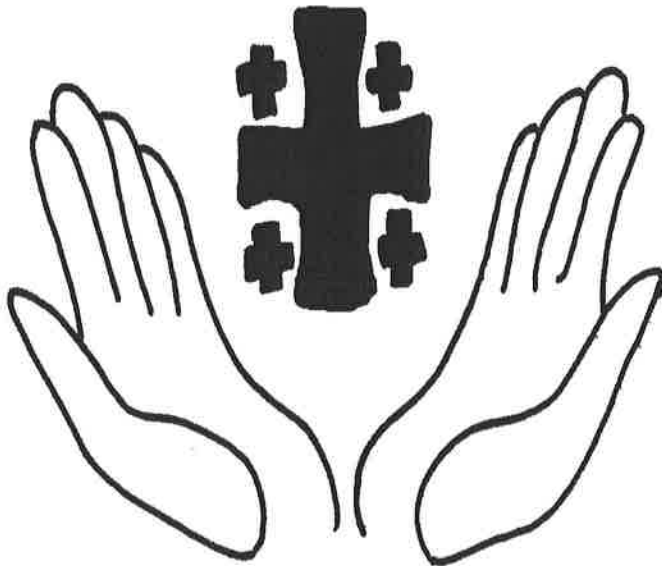

Baptism: Call the parish office for an appointment.

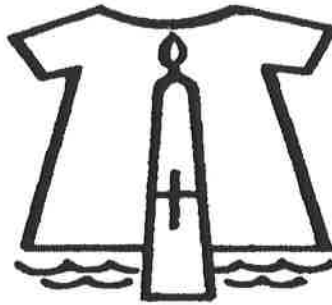
Wedding: Couples should make arrangements at least six months in advance. Call the parish office for further information.

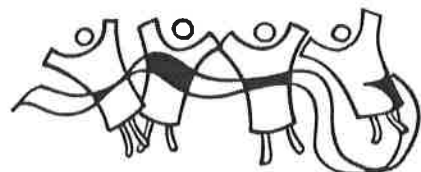

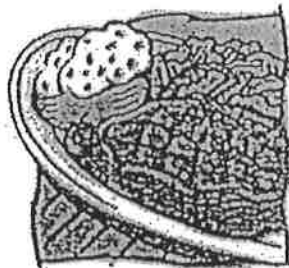
