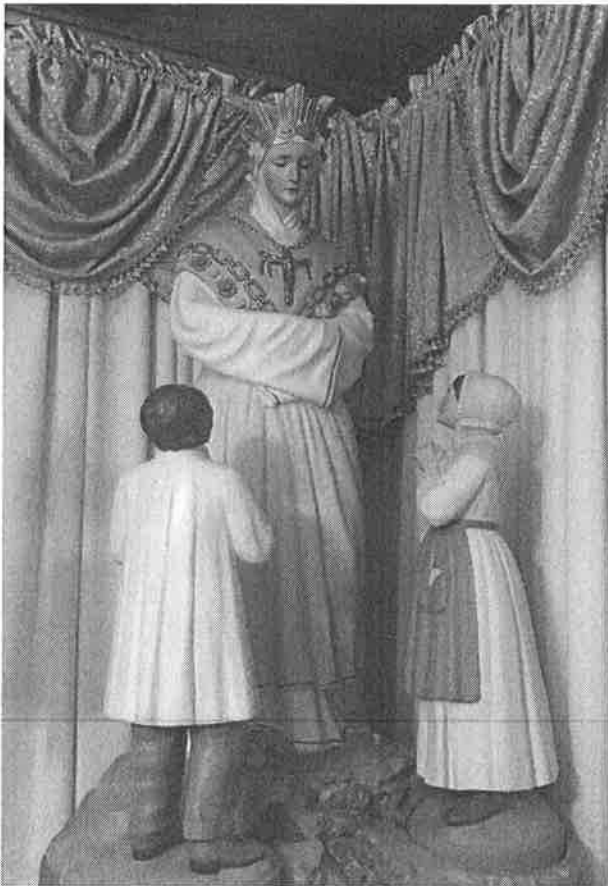

This year our beautiful church is in need of repairs on the roof and ceiling. All money this year will be given for this major project!

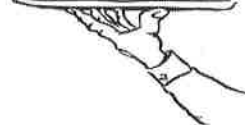

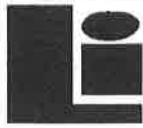
