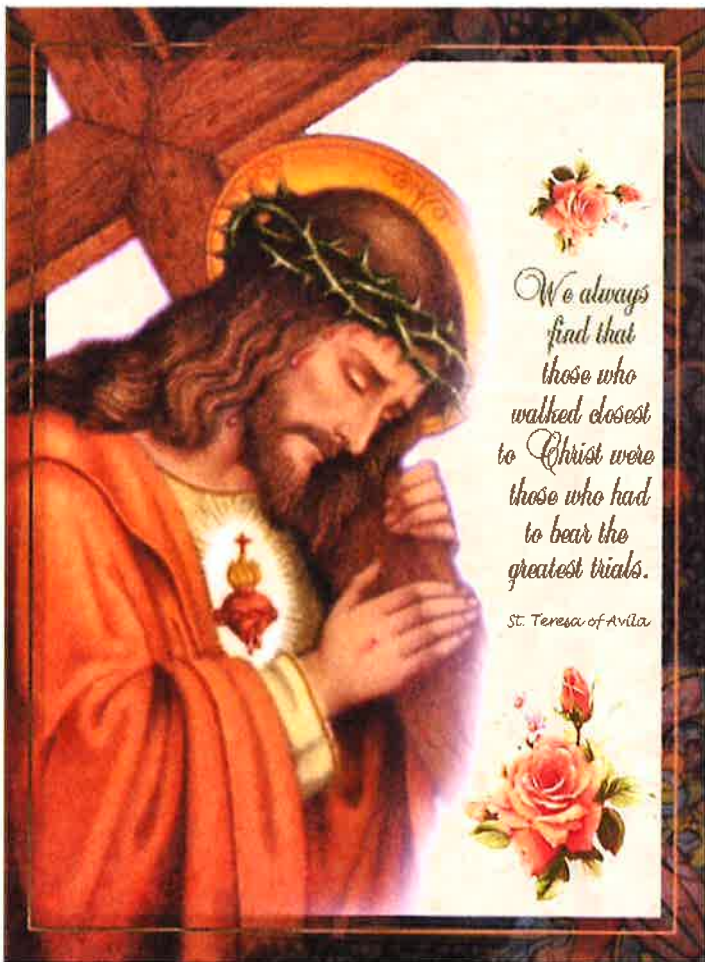

From Our Pastor & Pastoral Council

In response to Coronavirus guidelines:

Each of us entering church will be required to wear a face covering for the entire time we are in church.

The Holy Water fonts are empty. You may bring your personal container of Holy Water for your household to use.

Use of the Gather books have been temporarily discontinued.

There will not be an Entrance or Offertory Procession. We will have an offertory basket located in the back of church, near the vestibule, for you to place your offering in as you arrive to or depart from Mass.

When it is time for Holy Communion please remain in the pew until an usher signals you to exit. There will be a single line formed down the middle aisle where red crosses have been placed on the floor to help maintain social distancing.

Masks should be left on until we reach Father. At that point you should lower your mask and stretch out your hand. Father will then reverently drop the host into your hand. Place the host in your mouth and then put your mask over your mouth again.

For anyone sitting in front of the Blessed Virgin Mary, form a line in the aisle next to the wall to receive Holy Communion.

We ask that you do not linger in church after Mass but if you would like to help us wipe down the pews please stay to help.
