## Reflection from our Seminarian, Matthew Prosperie

"If you ask anything of me in my name, I will do it." -John 14: 12-14

These words of Jesus are golden- the key to everything. Jesus is giving us the ability to receive any gift, if we simply ask in His Name. And you remember what Scripture elsewhere says about Jesus' name: it is above every other name, the name at which every knee must bend in heaven, on earth and under the earth; the name which every tongue must confess, to the glory of God the Father: that Jesus Christ is *Lord*. (see Philippians 2:8-11) To pray to the Father in Jesus' *name* is to recognize that Jesus' name is *Lord of Heaven and Earth*. Now, to be Lord of something means you have absolute power over it, and Jesus is Lord of Heaven and Earth, which means He is Lord of *everything*.

But that means Jesus must also be the Lord of *our hearts*. We can ask Jesus to end to injustices, poverty, etc., and He could stop them, but if our hearts are not His, then the problems will all simply start up again, right from our own hearts: "For from the heart come evil thoughts, murder, adultery, unchastity, theft, false witness, blasphemy." (Matthew 15:19) The good news is that our hearts can be converted to a source of abundant goodness if we ask.

In conclusion, God can do anything. He is the all-powerful *Lord*. Yet, He limits Himself to be only as powerful as we allow Him to be. So why limit Him? Let's *ask* for the greatest of all gifts: that our hearts be filled like a cathedral with the Source of Goodness Himself, God. For, "A good person out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good, but an evil person out of a store of evil produces evil; *for from the fullness of the heart the mouth speaks.*" (Luke 6:45) God Himself is this "store of goodness" and "fullness of heart" we all desire. So, if we enthrone God as Lord in the tabernacle of our hearts, then our prayers for peace will certainly be heard. Indeed, our prayers, like our lives, will ring out like a beautiful song that carries the world to God.

Might I suggest one way we can all do this together? Come early to Mass every Sunday to pray the Rosary. The Rosary is one of God's greatest songs, and He allows us to join in it. It creates many harmonies of grace in the soul who prays it with love. By it, God gives graces you never thought you needed, but which unburden you from so many things. Pray it with confidence in God, and with constancy. Jesus came into the world through Mary's "yes." He wants to do the same today through Mary's Rosary, which always leads the world to Christ, who shines like a long-awaited dawn upon the world.
