## Reflection from our Seminarian, Matthew Prosperie

Images, and where they are placed, can lead us to be reminded of important things. This is true whether they are placed in Churches, or our homes. I recall an image of the Good Shepherd at my college in Rome. The fact that it is placed overlooking the city reminds me of how God picks us up like lost sheep, not just in any old way, but with the devotion of a loving, good shepherd. Shepherds normally dwell in the rural areas, but this Good Shepherd finds His sheep even in the city. He loves us, even after we stray, and no matter if we think we're out of the area of His Help, beyond His providential care, He shows us that He's willing to look EVERYWHERE for us. We're NEVER beyond His help, never too far to hear His voice, or to answer His voice, to receive His help.

Images, then, can remind us of important things. They can be God's way of speaking to us. Of course, these reminders mean much less than they could if, by being reminded of important truths, we do not in turn open ourselves to their ultimate benefit. How can we open ourselves to that? By praying. Any reflection on God's love for us, any hope in God's mercy instilled in us by images, any desire, longing for God's love, can be a path in fact to realizing that God is already calling out to us. Whether this realization comes through images made by man, or images made by God-- namely, man and woman, who are made in His image and likeness-- we find the real treasure of this realization, it's ultimate benefit, through prayer. And because God is the one who searches us out and comes to us, we don't have to wait, or fix ourselves, before we start praying. He's already there- here. And He in fact is seeking us- not despite our brokenness, but because of our brokenness: "For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost." (Luke 19:10) and "Jesus said to them, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners." Mark 2:17

He is the ultimate benefit, the ultimate treasure, the One whose voice we hear in images, because He does not remain in the fields of our imagination, nor in the far-out country of thoughts too high for us to think, of actions too hard for us to do. He comes to us in the busy-ness of our life. We have only to hear Him, see Him, in His images, and to respond, by letting Him put us on His shoulders. That's the first step to prayer, in which we encounter-- not an image, but the One who Made All Images-- not an image, but the Image-Maker--not an image, but the ultimate treasure which the image points to: God Himself.

Let us pray.

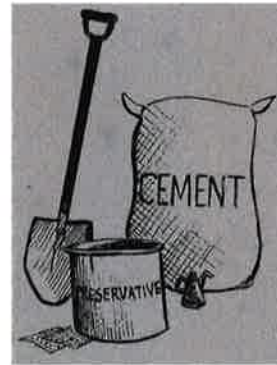
