- ♦ Eucharistic Jesus will then be processed out onto a boat, traveling from **9:15am to 11:15 am** up the bayou to Larose's Our Lady of the Rosary Church.
- ♦ From there, Eucharistic Jesus will be moved onto the back of an old fire truck.
- ♦ From **12:00pm to 1:30pm**, He will be driven up the bayou from church to church until reaching St. Joseph's cemetery in Thibodaux.
- ♦ Eucharistic Jesus will then be carried on foot in procession to St. Thomas Aquinas at Nicholls, where the event aims to conclude with outdoor vespers and benediction at **2:30pm**.
