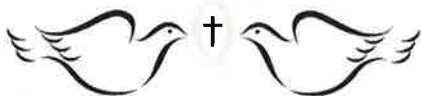

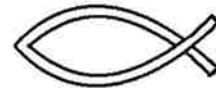

Reflection for today's Scripture

The story of the multiplication of the loaves and the fishes recalls a particular aspect of the Mass. In this miracle, Jesus transforms a young boy's offering of five barley loaves and two fish.

In the offertory at Mass, we present the fruits of our labors, represented by bread and wine. These gifts, given to us first by God as grain and fruit, are returned to God in our offering of thanksgiving. God in turn transforms our gifts, making this bread and wine the very Body and Blood of Jesus. We also offer ourselves in this exchange, and we, too, are transformed by the Eucharist.



Receiving The Eucharist

At communion time, if you wish to receive the Blessed Sacrament on the tongue, please remember to go to Father Jean-Marie.

Father will distribute the Eucharist to those wishing to receive on the tongue OR in the hand.

Lay ministers will only distribute the Eucharist to those receiving in the hand.

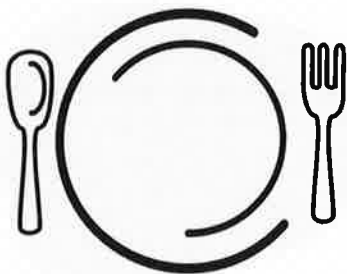

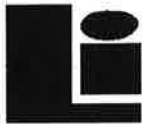
