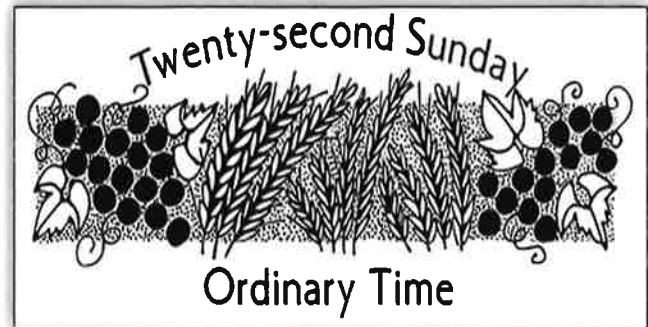
Scripture Readings for August 28/29
