Family Involvement Commitment (FIC) 2020 – 2021

The purpose of Family Involvement Commitment (FIC) is to promote equal participation among the families of the school and generate funds. Participating in SMMCS is one of the most important things a parent can do. This program provides an opportunity to meet and work with terrific people.

Guidelines:

- All families K3 through 8th Grade are required to participate in the Family Involvement Commitment.

A. Fundraising commitment

- Two parent household - \$200
- One parent household - \$100

Fundraising commitments can be reached through the following:

1. Fundraising

Fall Festival Raffle Tickets

\$amount = to 50% of sales

Spring Raffle Tickets

\$amount = to 50% of sales

2. Donations/Gifts/Msgr. Paul Procella Legacy Fund, items/resources donated and accepted as needed.

B. Volunteer hours commitment

- Two parent household – 15 Hours
- One parent household – 10 Hours

EXAMPLES: Field trip chaperone

Volunteer for SMMCS events

If volunteering hours are not met, they then become fundraising commitment. At the end of the school year, the remaining volunteer hours will be converted into a \$10 per hour fundraising commitment.

(Example: 10 hours remaining = \$100 fundraising commitment)

- Your participation in this program is recorded and will be available for your review.
- Items and/or money donated for class and/or teacher projects **may not** be used toward FIC requirements.
- Families **may not** trade or donate FIC credits to other families.
- When working at an event or activity, it is your responsibility to document your time on the FIC cards, which are available in the front office or at the event. It is also your responsibility to get the **event/activity coordinator or Mrs. Laura Rocha** to sign your form. After completing the form, you must return it to the school's front office and deposit it into the Family Involvement Commitment Box for recording purposes.
