The Frassati Catholic Student Ambassadors are a team of sophomores, juniors, and seniors who serve Frassati Catholic High School in an outstanding leadership capacity. Working directly with the Student Ambassador sponsor, as well as cooperatively with the Executive Council, Student Ambassadors serve as liaisons with prospective students as well as any visitors to the school. The ultimate mission of the Student Ambassadors is to help communicate the vision of Frassati Catholic High School to everyone. This is accomplished through formal events as well as informal encounters, helping to create a culture that is in keeping with the truth about the human person who is destined to share in God's own divine life.

A member of the Student Ambassadors first and foremost strives to live the mission of Frassati Catholic High School, which is embodied in the school's patron, Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati. Student Ambassadors must meet the following criteria:

Zealous Student

- Maintain a 3.0 G.P.A.
- Possess a positive attitude towards study; strive to do their best so that they can place their knowledge and skills at the service of others
- Follow the academic honor code: neither copying or allowing another to copy homework, not discussing tests that other classmates will take at a later time, careful to document sources so as to avoid plagiarism

True Friend

- Be an active member of at least one school extracurricular activity.
- Live by the Frassati Catholic High School Code of Conduct and Dress Code

Witness of Holiness

- Attend at least one morning Mass on campus each month to pray for Frassati Catholic students (Masses are held on Mondays and Tuesdays at 7:00 in our chapel).
- Participate fully in the retreat days.
- Assist with retreats as requested, assuming a mentorship role and helping the students enter fully into the day so that they may grow in their relationship with Christ.

Servant of the Poor

- Assist with supervising freshmen duties
- Participate fully in the Pier Giorgio Service Program

Virtuous Athlete

- Work on building good habits of daily exercise and healthy eating. Because our bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit and the instruments through which we can lead and serve others, it is important to have both sound mind and sound body.

Other specific responsibilities for the 2020-21 school year include but are not limited to:

- Attend orientation and planning meeting the week of August 3
- Assist at Student Orientation days: August 10 and 11
- Attend monthly meetings; day and time TBD
- Serve as mentors for new students
- Serve as hosts for 8th grade visit days and for prospective students who shadow throughout the year

- Participate in Admissions Outreach events, i.e. attending parish fall festivals and visiting Catholic elementary schools to talk with prospective students
- Assist at Open House on October 18 from 2:00-4:00 p.m.
- Assist at Open House on January 11 from 6:00-8:00 p.m.
- Assist at Family Fun Fest on March 27 from 4:00-8:00 p.m.
- Assist at Welcome Night on April 27 at 7:00 p.m.

If selected as a Student Ambassador for Frassati Catholic High School, I agree to meet or exceed the following expectations during my year on as a Student Ambassador:

- Conduct myself in a Christian manner at all times in my words and actions
- Live the mission of Frassati Catholic both on and off campus including online on the internet; strive to contribute to a culture that is in keeping with the dignity of the human person
- Attend at least one morning Mass on campus each month to pray for Frassati Catholic students (Masses are held on Mondays and Tuesdays at 7:00 in our chapel)
- Be a positive role model
- Be honest in all situations
- Keep a positive attitude, be cheerful
- Treat others how I wish to be treated, hold the doors for others, clean up after myself
- Live by the Frassati Catholic High School Code of Conduct and Dress Code
- Remain free of alcohol, tobacco, and illicit drugs and encourage others to do the same
- Focus on my academics and spirituality, striving to reach my full potential as a student leader
- Make it my personal mission to help everyone – students, parents, teachers, and others – feel welcome on the Frassati Catholic campus
- Arrive 10 minutes early to each event, stay until the event is over or my shift is complete, help clean up
- Alert Student Ambassadors sponsor and find a replacement in a timely manner if I am unable to fulfill an obligation.
