

Holy Family Dress Codes - Updated April 2019

The purpose of the dress code is to promote a look of pride and community among Holy Family students while reflecting good taste, neatness, cleanliness, and Christian modesty. Students reflect pride in themselves and our school by their dress and actions. We expect everyone to abide by these guidelines. Parents of students in violation will be notified.

LASALLE MIDDLE SCHOOL

Pants/Slacks

Plain solid navy, gray, khaki, brown or black dress slacks or cargo pants are permitted. Slacks should be modest and appropriate in fit, to the ankle. Jeans, spandex, and athletic wear are not permitted. No excessive zippers, buttons, or adornments.

Shorts/Capris (August/Sept. & May/June) In Aug., Sept., May, and June, students may wear dress shorts or cargo shorts that are solid color (khaki, navy, gray, brown, or black). These must reach at least to student fingertips.

Shirts/Blouses

Long or short-sleeved solid color or striped polos, turtlenecks, or collared dress shirts are allowed. Logos that appear on shirts shall be no larger than the size of a quarter. Shirts must be tucked in at all times and long enough to stay tucked in. Shirts must be buttoned up so as to reflect Christian modesty (one button from the top) and should be modest in fit.

Sweaters/Quarter-Zip

Solid colored or patterned dress sweaters, cardigans, and sweater vests are acceptable (no hoods). Only LaSalle or Xavier $\frac{1}{4}$ zip fleece is allowed. All sweaters and $\frac{1}{4}$ zip must be worn with a tucked-in collared shirt or turtleneck underneath. Sweaters must be waist length or longer.

Shoes/Socks

Only closed-toe and closed heel dress shoes or tennis shoes may be worn. Socks must be worn at all times.

Spirit Days Only Holy Family, LaSalle, St. Jude, or Xavier shirts or outerwear are permitted on Spirit Days. V-necks are allowed only if a crew neck t-shirt is worn underneath. Necklines must reflect Christian modesty and shirts should be modest in fit. Jeans or sweatpants are allowed (free of holes, rips, tears). In August, September, May, and June, students may wear dress code shorts or loose-fitting basketball-style athletic shorts.

Dress Reward Days

Spirit Day attire w/ these exceptions... On designated days, t-shirts or sweatshirts with appropriate slogans may be worn. Outerwear is permitted

Hair

Hair is to be neat and well groomed. Neither extreme hairstyles nor extreme hair color is permitted.

Earrings

Small earrings (no bigger than a quarter) Excessive earrings or other piercings are not allowed.

Make-up

Female students only Only mascara, blush, and clear lip gloss are allowed.

Current Clothing Trends

ST. JUDE CENTER - Updated 6/11/20

Pants/Slacks:

- o **PLAIN**, solid color in navy, gray, khaki, brown or black
- o corduroy, cotton stretch, or dress pants
- o ankle length
- o no jeans, spandex or athletic type wear
- o No excessive zippers, buttons or adornments
- o No excessively tight fitting pants

Skirts/Jumpers/Skortis:

- o solid color navy, gray, khaki, brown or black
- o length is to be longer than mid-thigh
- o Plain, solid colored leggings allowed under skirts/jumpers/skortis
- o No dresses

Shorts/Capris:

- o solid color navy, gray, khaki, brown or black
- o permitted in Aug., Sept, May, and June only or at the discretion of the administrator depending on the weather
- o shorts length is to be longer than mid-thigh

Shirts:

- o any solid color (one color only)
- o collared polos, dress shirts, turtlenecks, or mock turtlenecks (no denim, flannel, or thermal)
- o shirts must have sleeves
- o shirts worn under dress attire shirts must follow dress attire guidelines; can also include crew neckline
- o small (no larger than quarter sized) logos or insignias are allowed
- o hooded shirts are not allowed
- o must be tucked in

Sweaters/Vests:

- o any solid color (no hoods)
- o must be worn with dress code shirt beneath
- o only approved Holy Family/Xavier sweatshirts are allowed (no hoods)
- o no outerwear or outerwear fleece may be worn during the school day

Shoes/Socks:

- o only closed toe and closed heel shoes
- o no boots are allowed during the school day except for snow boots needed at recess
- o matching socks must be worn at all times
- o must be non-marking
- o no Heeley shoes(roller style shoes) allowed
- o knee highs or tights must be plain, solid color

Head Gear:

- o hats, caps, or other head coverings are not allowed during the school day

Miscellaneous:

- o simple earrings are acceptable; no dangling earrings
- o clothes must be in good repair (no holes)
- o Approved clubs and student groups may wear uniforms on meeting days
- o Student's natural hair color only
- o Extreme hair style including shaved hair, shaved in numbers, symbols or wording and/or Mohawk style hair is not allowed
- o free dress passes are allowed only on non-liturgical days

Spirit Days:

- o Holy Family or Xavier shirts are permitted on Spirit Day
- o plain shirts in Holy Family spirit colors of silver, blue, green or black may be worn
- o jeans and sportswear attire, including sweatpants, are acceptable
- o Students not observing Spirit Day must be in regular dress code

\$1.00 Jean Days:

- o Shirt or sweatshirt that is school appropriate
- o Jeans, sweat pants or sport pants
- o No boots
- o Students not observing \$1.00 Jean Day must be in regular school attire

Final decisions about the appropriateness/inappropriateness rests with school administration
