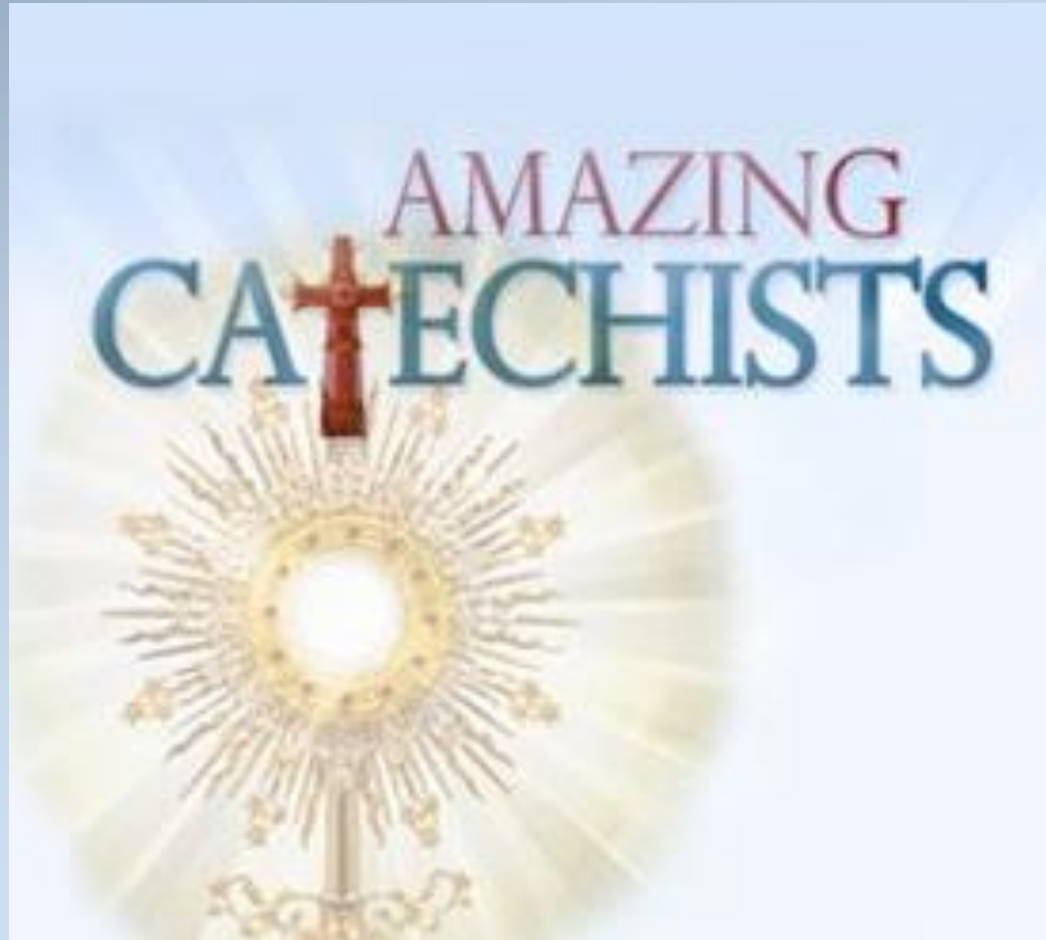

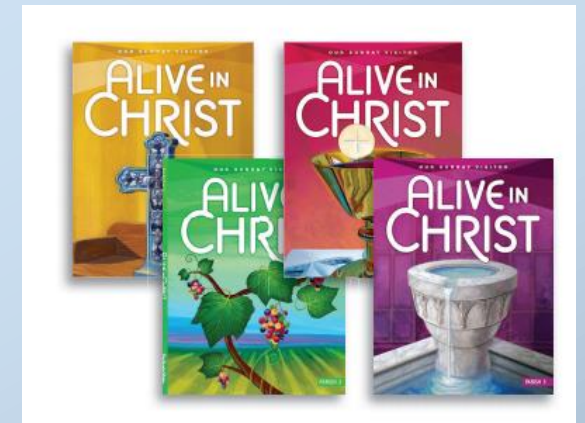
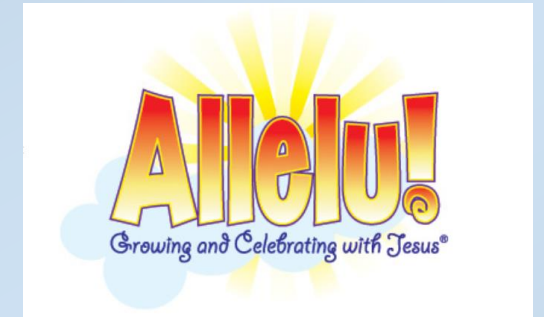

# When are the Zoom Faith Formation Classes?

- Church School (PK & Kindergarteners) will meet weekly on Sundays at 9 AM starting on October 4<sup>th</sup>
- Middle School (6-8<sup>th</sup> Graders) meet weekly on Sundays from 6:30-7:30 PM starting on October 4<sup>th</sup>
- Elementary School (1-5<sup>th</sup> Graders) meet weekly on Tuesdays from 5-6 PM starting on October 6<sup>th</sup>
- High School (9-12<sup>th</sup> Graders) meet bi-monthly on Sundays from 6:30-7:30 PM starting on October 4<sup>th</sup>
