Happy Birthday Diocese of Dallas

On July 15, 1890, one-hundred-and-twenty-five years ago, Pope Leo XIII erected the Diocese of Dallas. Because of the July heat and the absence of so many on vacations, birthday celebrations are postponed until the fall and winter. A number of festivities are planned to celebrate the event. Every pastor will set a date to observe the Quasiquicentennial in their parish. A diocesan 125th Anniversary observance will take place Saturday, October 3rd at Cathedral Guadalupe. More details on these events will be forthcoming in The Texas Catholic and online at www.cathdal.org/125.

However, the July 15 anniversary date will not pass unobserved. Prologue to the Future, an eBook history of the Diocese of Dallas, has been released at www.cathdal.org/prologue. It is comprehensive and features many photographs, and may be downloaded to your computer or tablet. I hope you will read and enjoy this interesting, chronological history of our diocese.

I was asked to write an introduction to Prologue to the Future. It seems appropriate to first release it in this blog to mark the anniversary of Pope Leo's bull that brought this great diocese into being.

Every story has a pre-story. Any one moment is but a point on the continuum of time. When Pope Leo XIII declared July 15, 1890, as the moment the Diocese of Dallas would come into being, that event, like all events, was the culmination of a succession of occurrences. When a diocese is erected, it does not establish a new church; rather it establishes a formal ministerial structure for a church that already exists.

In the northernmost reaches of Texas that would become the Diocese of Dallas, from the Piney Woods to the Chihuahua Desert, the Church arrived with the first Catholic. For where there is even one Catholic, there is the Church. We know not where or when the Catholic continuum began that came to fruition with Pope Leo's Bull, but we do know that, like the mustard seed, it was destined for prodigious growth.

We stand at the convergence of what has been and what will be in the continuum that is the Catholic Diocese of Dallas. As we mark our 125th anniversary, we celebrate the faith of our Catholic forbearers who nurtured the mustard seed that has become the diocese. We are tomorrow's forbearers. We are those into whose hands God has placed the future of our faith and our children. Let us not be found wanting.

¡Feliz Cumpleaños Diócesis de Dallas!

El 15 de julio de 1890, hace ya ciento veinticinco años, el Papa León XIII erigió la Diócesis de Dallas. Debido al calor del mes de julio y la ausencia de tantas personas que se encuentran vacacionando, las celebraciones de aniversario han sido pospuestas hasta el otoño y el invierno. Se han planificado una serie de festividades para la celebración del evento. Cada párroco dedicará una fecha para conmemorar el ciento veinticincoavo aniversario en su parroquia. El sábado 3 de octubre tendrá lugar una Conmemoración del 125avo Aniversario diocesano en la catedral. Próximamente tendremos más detalles acerca de estos eventos en The Texas Catholic y en línea visitando www.cathdal.org/125.

Sin embargo, el 15 de julio, fecha del aniversario, no pasará desapercibido. Prologue to the Future (Prólogo para el Futuro), un libro electrónico de la historia de la Diócesis de Dallas, será publicado en www.cathdal.org/prologue en dicha fecha. El libro es extenso y consta de muchas fotografías y además puede ser descargado en computadora o tablet. Espero que lo lea y disfrute de esta interesante historia cronológica de nuestra diócesis.

Me pidieron que escribiera una introducción al Prólogo para el Futuro y me parece oportuno publicarla primeramente en este blog en conmemoración del aniversario de la bula del Papa León que dio lugar a la creación de nuestra diócesis.

Toda historia tiene una historia previa. Todo momento no es sino un punto en la secuencia del tiempo. Cuando el Papa León XIII declaró el 15 de julio de 1890, como el momento en que nacería la Diócesis de Dallas, ese evento, al igual que todos los eventos, fue la culminación de una sucesión de acontecimientos. Cuando se erige una diócesis, ésta no establece una nueva iglesia; más bien establece una estructura ministerial formal de una iglesia ya existente.

Al lugar más remoto del norte de Texas que se convertiría en la Diócesis de Dallas, desde los bosques de Piney Woods hasta el desierto de Chihuahua, llegó la Iglesia con el primer Católico, porque donde hay por lo menos un Católico, ahí está la Iglesia. No sabemos dónde o cuándo comenzó la continuidad Católica que se produjo con la bula del Papa León, pero sabemos que, al igual que la semilla de mostaza, ésta estaba destinada a un crecimiento prodigioso.

Nos encontramos en la convergencia de lo que ha sido y será la continuidad que es la Diócesis Católica de Dallas. Al conmemorar nuestro 125avo aniversario, celebramos la Fe de nuestros antepasados Católicos que cultivaron la semilla de mostaza en la que se ha convertido la diócesis. Somos antepasados del mañana. Somos aquellos en cuyas manos Dios ha puesto el futuro de nuestra fe y nuestros hijos. No lo defraudemos.
