Message from Father Hinterschied

Father Michael McGivney, the founder of the Knights of Columbus, will be beatified on October 31. He will be the first American parish priest to be so honored. He can be viewed as a martyr of a pandemic, as he died of complications from pneumonia at age 38 in 1890, during an outbreak of influenza known as the Russian flu. Some recent evidence, according to the Knights, indicates the outbreak may have been the result of a coronavirus.

On May 27, the Holy Father signed the decree recognizing a miracle through the intercession of Father McGivney, thus clearing the way for his beatification.

The miracle occurred in 2015 and involved an U.S. baby, who is now five years old. His parents prayed to Father McGivney to intercede to God to save their son, still in his mother's womb, who was given no hope of surviving fetal hydrops.

McGivney (1852-1890) was the son of Irish immigrants and was ordained a priest in 1877. He founded the Knights of Columbus in 1882.

Originally started as a service organization to help widows and orphans, this fraternal order for Catholic men has become the largest lay Catholic organization in the world with two million members and sponsors a wide range of educational, charitable and religious activities. We are proud to have a council of Knights of Columbus here at St. Patrick, and equally proud of what these fine men do for our parish and community!

The Mass of Beatification will be live-streamed, details are available at fathermcgivney.org.


Some years ago I was sent to be the new pastor of a rather large parish. One of the first things I noticed was that the exit from the church parking lot to the busy street we bordered had three staggered signposts, each of which read: "Thou shalt not park here." I jokingly referred to these signs as "the eleventh commandment."

Parish life, in all its parts, forms and sends people as intentional disciples of Jesus. Our discipleship, according to scripture, is expressed in the infinite number of ways in which we follow today's Great Commandment – to love God with our whole being and to love others as ourselves – as well as creatively participate in the Great Commission (Matthew 28: 19-20) – to go/make/baptize/teach disciples. These are the "whole" that interprets the "parts."

As I continually and consistently shared this vision with staff, individuals, and groups within the parish, it was amazing to see and experience a transformation of parish culture. The Holy Spirit moved many to embrace the charge and mission rather than to consume the product. Parish life began to happen more off-grounds than on.

A few years into my term in this parish, staff members and other parish leaders confronted me about those signs at the exit. They wanted to know why we were giving such a negative message ("Thou Shalt NOT..") to folks as they were leaving the property. I was thrilled to follow-up on their suggestion that we replace "the eleventh commandment" with three new signs on these same posts. They now read, 'Love God,' "Love Others," "Make Disciples."

**SAINT JUDE THADDEUS,
APOSTLE**FEAST DAY OCTOBER 28
PATRON OF LOST CAUSES

Jude's father was a martyr, and his mother kindly stood at the cross and anointed Christ's body after His death. He was actually the nephew of Mary and Joseph, and it is said that he looked very much like his cousin Jesus. His patronage of impossible causes stems from confusion between him and Judas. Since early Christians prayed for Judas' help and not to Jude Thaddeus, devotion to Jude was "a lost cause." Jude was killed with a club and beheaded after his death in Persia during the first century. His relics were distributed in Rome and France.
