- **Did you know** – The use of the lot is for the license holder(s) or their relatives for interment only, and right of interment granted therein is not transferable, for sale or profit.
- **Did you know** – All in-ground interments, casket or urn, must be placed in an outer burial container made of concrete or other durable material.
- **Did you know** – Decorations, shrubbery, ornaments pots, etc. that are not taken care of will be removed by the caretakers.
- **Did you know** – That no planting of trees is allowed.
