#### Christ Our Hope – Building a Vibrant Church

Proverbs 28:27: "He that giveth unto the poor shall not lack but he that hideth his eyes shall have many a curse."

God calls us to support the most vulnerable among us and the Christ Our Hope: Building a Vibrant Church campaign offers us the opportunity to do that. A portion of the dollars raised will fund an endowment for Catholic Charities so it may expand its ability to serve the needy. This is a pressing need because Catholic Charities cannot serve – on average 70 families or 280 people – per month. Beyond that need, the campaign offers great hope at home here at Mary Queen of All Saints. Sixty cents of every dollar will come to us. While considering your gift, it is worth remembering that a key provision of the CARES Act states that a donor may deduct 100% of any gift to a qualified charity against their 2020 adjusted gross income. Please note this deduction expires at the end of 2020.
