April is National Child Abuse Prevention Month:

Did you know? The Diocese of Burlington will pray for individuals who suffer from abuse and neglect...The Diocese of Burlington will be hosting a Night of Healing Prayer to remember those who have suffered, or are currently suffering, from abuse and neglect. The date and time will be posted on the Diocesan calendar of events available at:

If you suspect a child or minor is being abused or neglected, call the Vermont Department of Children and Families (DCF) at 1-800-649-5285 to make a report. This number is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. You can make an anonymous report, and you will not be penalized for any report made in good faith. If a minor or child is in immediate danger, dial 911. Follow up by making a report to DCF. The Diocese of Burlington also provides a Victim Assistance Coordinator. If you or anyone you know has been a victim of abuse by someone representing the Catholic Church, please call 802-855-3016 for help.
