As part of the Diocese of Burlington's continuing commitment to protect young people, adults who have direct contact with minors at our parishes and Catholic schools must complete all safe environment requirements. These include participation in annual child abuse prevention training; submission of background check paperwork; reading of the Diocesan Policies on Ethics and Integrity in Ministry; and signing of a Code of Conduct.
