**STOP PROP 5:** Proposal 5 is a legislative proposal to amend the Vermont Constitution with pro-abortion language. Proponents of Prop 5 stated publicly that their goal is to ensure unlimited, unregulated abortion throughout all nine months of pregnancy. Prop 5 equals abortion on-demand. "People on both sides of the debate over abortion know that "reproductive autonomy" is publicly understood to be a way of referring to an unlimited abortion license, that is, elective abortion permitted through the entire 9 months of gestation and pregnancy up to and including the process of birth."
