

BAPTISM PREPARATION: Parents and godparents as well as witnesses are required to complete a baptism preparation course, which is offered at the parish church. For Baptism, at least ONE sponsor (godparent) must be a Baptized, Confirmed and practicing Roman Catholic. Godparents must submit a copy of their Baptism Certificate at the office if they were baptized outside the parish. Before your child can be baptized, the office must have a copy of your child's birth certificate. To register call, 891-1730. A church fee of \$25.00 is applicable for Baptisms. (Goodwill offering for the Priest is to be paid separately). Date for next preparations will be announced at a later date.
