

Baptism Preparation: A Fee is applicable for a Baptism and must be paid at the Parish Office before the Baptism takes place. Parents and godparents are required to complete a baptism preparation session and therefore must contact the parish office to make arrangements. **The next Baptism Preparation Session will be held on October 17th, 2021, at 1:00 p.m., in the Parish Church. To register, contact the parish office at 279-1625.** For Baptism, at least **one** sponsor (godparent) must be a baptized, confirmed and practicing Roman Catholic. **Godparents not baptized in this parish must submit a copy of their Baptismal Certificate at the Baptism Preparation Session.** Before your child can be baptized, the parish office **must** have a copy of your child's birth certificate. ***During the COVID-19 Pandemic, baptisms will take place after the 11:00 a.m. Sunday Mass.***

REGISTRATION FOR MASS ATTENDANCE: ***Registration for Mass on a weekly basis is required*** as we can accommodate up to **150** parishioners. Masks are required to be worn at all times. Any parishioner who has a health issue and cannot wear a mask is asked to contact the Parish Office. **If you are registered and are unable to attend for any reason, please contact the Parish Office and inform them.** These seats would then be available for other parishioners who may not have registered.

REPORTING SEXUAL ABUSE COMMITTED OR COVERED UP BY A BISHOP: On May 6th, 2021, the Bishops of Canada launched a national bilingual service for reporting situations of sexual abuse either committed or covered up by a bishop who is presently active or retired from ministry in a diocese in Canada. World Day of Migrants and Refugees
September 26th, 2021

A World Day of Migrants and Refugees is observed in many places in solidarity with the World Refugee Day promoted by the United Nations and observed since 2001 on June 20th. The January observance was instituted by Saint Pius X in 1914. At the request of several conferences of Bishops, Pope Francis moved the observance to September in 2019. "The phenomenon of migration today is a providential opportunity for the proclamation of the Gospel in the contemporary world. Men and women from various regions of the earth who have not yet encountered Jesus Christ or know him only partially, ask to be received in countries with an ancient Christian tradition. It is necessary to find adequate ways for them to meet and to become acquainted with Jesus Christ and to experience the invaluable gift of salvation." (Pope Benedict XVI, 2012)
