Reflection by Javier:

As we continue to adventure in this ordinary time, Matthew, the evangelist, presents Jesus beginning his mission: announcing the presence of the Kingdom and calling his listeners to repentance. We are presented with the commonly called "sermon on the Mount," the first of the five sections of extended teaching of Jesus, whom Matthew projects as a true Teacher and interpreter of the Law. We learn that the poor in spirit, those who mourn, the meek, those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, the merciful, the clean of heart, the peacemakers, those persecuted for the sake of righteousness, and those persecuted with false charges because of their belief are blessed. Jesus' teaching assures them that in the Reign of God, they are "in" and as such, they belong, they are blessed. The Beatitudes assure the hearers of their belonging. In doing so, Jesus lifts them up with the promise of blessing.

How do we, as individuals and as communities of faith, welcome, offer hospitality, assure dignity, and promise blessing to those "on the margins" of our acquaintances, our Universities, our family, our communities, our places of worship, our workplaces, our neighborhoods, our world? How do we reach out and include those who are forgotten and neglected by today's standards of society? Let's don't forget: "God choose the foolish of the world to shame the wise, and God chose the weak of the world to shame the strong, and God chose the lowly and despise of the world, those who count for nothing, to reduce to nothing those who are something, so that no human being might boast before God (1Cor. 1:27-29)."
