## Reflection by Deacon Javier:

The Gospel of Matthew is moving to the part of the Sermon on the Mount that scholars call the six antitheses. The label intends to highlight the fact that here, six times in a row, the words of Jesus follow a pattern that goes, "you have heard that it was said... But I say to you..." Here we meet Jesus asserting and authority even greater than that of Moses.

What is new is his interpretation of the law, which at times was at odds with that of other religious leaders of his day. His is not a lax interpretation, but one that is even more demanding than theirs. To truly keep the law, one must go beyond it. Jesus speaks to his disciples about the little things that can erode their relationship with God and others and escalate into major offenses.

As Jesus instructs his disciples to watch out for the little transgressions, he did not intend to frighten them into obeying a God who was lying in wait to punish them for every single mistake. He warns them that little slights, left unchecked, can lead to major offenses, with dire consequences. By the same token, great love and greatness in God's reign begin with little acts of love toward the least brother or sister. One saint who epitomizes this teaching is St. Thérèse of Lisieux. Through her "little way," she resolved to love all those she encountered in all the routine and ordinary interchanges of everyday life. Her greatness was recognized by her canonization only twenty-eight years after her death and a century later she was given the title of doctor of the church.

So, as you go about this week think that day by day we are challenge to love more and love better. It is in this way that we are truly Christians, truly sister and brothers in the Kingdom of God.
