El Día de los Muertos/Day of the Dead

El Día de los Muertos is an occasion to gather as a family for prayer and *convivencia*. The practice surrounding *Día de los Muertos* is a celebration of the sacredness of life that emanated from Pre-Hispanic cultures and has become an important moment for the entire Latin@ Community in the United States.

El Día de los Muertos is a seasonal celebration of life. An important expression of enculturated faith. The construction of altars called *ofrendas* or offerings takes on different forms in the regions of México. The *ofrendas* are decorated with sugar skulls, skeletons, toys, marigolds, sacred images, foods, beverages, and pictures of deceased loved ones.

Like any cultural celebration, the rituals and symbols may not be familiar to us. What may appear macabre—the presence of skulls, skeletons, candles, graves, images of deceased loved ones, souls present, the embodiment of death in a sculpture or image—actually makes the same core claim to the Abrahamic traditions—that life, not death, had the final word. For this reason the skulls are painted to express joy, the skeletons are dressed to dance and celebrate, the marigolds are abound to invite the spirit of our deceased loved ones to join us, and the finest foods are prepared to bring us together as one family to eat and celebrate the gift of life.

On Sunday, November 4, the UCM (Hispanic/Latinx Student Organization at CCM) will construct the *ofrenda* for the wider CCM Community. We would like to invite you to join us for *El Día de los Muertos* celebration which will take place on Tuesday, November 6, at 6 pm. We will have a prayer service and traditional food. Your presence will help celebrate our communion with the Hispanic-Latin@ Community, the entire CCM Family, and with God.

We look forward to seeing you at this wonderful occasion to celebrate life!

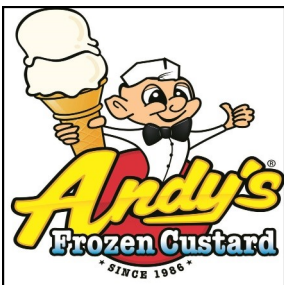
