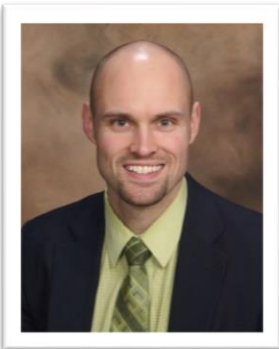

WORKSHOPS TO BE OFFERED

Peer Ministry:

This workshop will focus on what it means to be a Peer Minister at CCM. Peer Ministers are student leaders from Drury, MSU, and OTC who serve in a particular area of ministry as positive role models with and amongst their peers.

Small Group Leader:

This workshop will focus on how to be a small group leader at CCM. A small group leader guides a group of peers through an area of faith formation. Some areas include weekly Mass Readings, Theology of the Body, or other topics of the Catholic faith.

One-on-One Discipleship:

This workshop will focus on how to guide and accompany peers into deeper friendship with Jesus through one-one-one regular encounters.

Liturgical Ministry:

This workshop will focus on being a leader as a minister in the liturgy.

Social Justice:

This workshop will focus on how to be a leader while working on social justice. There will be an emphasis on working with Catholic Relief Services through CCM.
