***Focus 2020 With New Eyes, Fresh Vision and
Pure Hearts
Advent, Christmas and New Year***

Dear Church Family,

With Christmas only twenty-four days away and the New Year of 2020 just around the corner, let's take some time on this First Sunday of Advent and intentionally focus on our Savior's Birth, and the coming New Year. Our theme for this season and the year 2020 will be "FOCUS 2020 With New Eyes, Fresh Vision and Pure Hearts." Here are some ways how we might improve our spiritual vision:

Spiritual Reading: Commit to reading the scriptures each day of Advent using your Bible or the Word Among Us which is available FREE in the back of church.

Mass Attendance: God's greatest gift to us is the Holy Eucharist which we are blessed to receive when we come to Mass. Why not make a real effort to come to Mass each Sunday. However, sometimes it is hard to make Mass each Sunday, so our weekday Mass at 8:00am, Monday through Friday, might be an option to consider.

Confession Is Good For The Soul: A great remedy for removing the blindness caused by sin is the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Why not restore your vision in 2020 by receiving this sacrament. Confessions will be available after the weekend Masses throughout Advent.

Adult Bible Study: Our weekly Adult Bible Study will focus on the birth of Jesus and those scriptures from the Bible that deal with the Incarnation. These special sessions will meet on December 4, 11, and 18 in the rectory. This might be a great opportunity for people who not regular Bible Study participants. We meet at 7:30 and enjoy some interesting lessons and lively discussions.

2. *Put 84576 in the field.*
3. *Put stm4265 (all lower case) in the body of text.*
4. *Hit "Send."*
5. *Click the link in the reply message*
6. *Complete the name page, hit save.*
7. *Choose your groups, hit next*
8. *Complete the rest of the fields, hit save.*
9. *You will receive an email to verify your email address, click verify my email*
10. *You will receive another email to create a password, click create password*
11. *Once your password is set it will log you into Flock Notes.*
