As we observe the birthday of Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. I want to share some of Dr. King's words for your reflection.

Dr. King said:

"I have decided to stick with love...Hate is too great a burden to bear."

"Our lives begin to end the day we become silent about things that matter."
