First Sunday of Advent

Dear Church Family,

Here we are, Church family!! It’s Advent. And that means that in just four weeks it will be Christmas!! The Christmas tree lots appear each year the day after Thanksgiving. This year, despite the pandemic, is no different.

Advent prepares us for the coming of the Savior. We must ask ourselves, “from what do we need saving?” The scriptures of Advent challenge us to wait for the day of the Lord, but they also demand that we work for justice. How appropriate for the times that we live in! In the Biblical sense, justice (Hebrew: hesed) refers the right relationship we need to have with God as evidenced by our behavior toward God’s people. We are warned that the demands of justice are not just mere “suggestions”; they are commands. Advent asks the tough question: How are we living hesed relationship with God? If we are God’s people, if we are in covenant relationship with God, then we must be working for justice wherever there is injustice. Are you up to the Advent challenge in this year of pandemic and social and political unrest?
