Bishop Cahill has extended the dispensation from the Sunday Mass obligation through the **end of July** so that those who are most vulnerable/weak--or simply concerned due to the Pandemic in general--may continue to do so absent the concern about not properly honoring or keeping the Sabbath Day. The parish continues to livestream the 9 A.M. Mass each weekend for those who would like to maintain a connection with their “familiar” spiritual surroundings.
