Top three male & female runners in each category & top three overall.

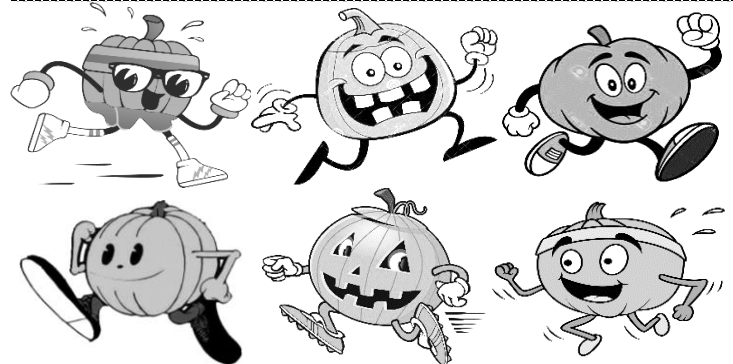
