Planning Ahead

The ongoing concerns regarding the pandemic and precautions are with us for the unforeseen future. In order to do some basic preparation regarding Christmas in light of necessary restrictions, the Christmas schedule will have to be adjusted. First, there simply is no safe way to have the "traditional" children's liturgy. Second, there is no practical way to have the evening vigil at St. Ann and accommodate even half of the attendance we normally have there.

Therefore, this year the schedule will be altered slightly to offer the opportunity in light of the distancing requirements. All of the Masses will be at St. Joseph due to higher limits of restricted seating capacity. One of the Masses will be livestreamed (yet to be determined).
