## EUCCHARISTIC IDEAS FOR LENT

--Get to daily Mass during Lent.

--If you can't do Mass daily during Lent, go to Mass on Fridays in addition to Sunday and thank Him for laying his life down for you. Maybe you can go another time or two as well during the Lenten season.

--Go to the Friday Stations of the Cross--there's two options--with the school or in the evening--or simply stop by the Church and pray and follow the Way of the Cross on your own.

--Spend at least 30 minutes in the presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament at least one time during each week of Lent. This doesn't have to be in front of the Blessed Sacrament visible in the monstrance. Sitting quietly in front of the tabernacle is just as powerful.

--Recover the Catholic tradition of making frequent visits to the Blessed Sacrament throughout the week, even if it is only for 5 minutes.

--Even if you can't get to daily Mass, get a daily Catholic Missal or go online to [uscba.org](http://uscba.org) to get a list of the readings used each day in Mass, and read these daily during Lent.
