#### Christ is Risen!



# St. Joseph School Sets Registration March 22<sup>nd</sup> – April 30<sup>th</sup>

St. Joseph School will begin registration for new and returning students for the 2021-2022 school year beginning March 22<sup>nd</sup> through April 30<sup>th</sup>.

For new enrollees, parents and students are required to participate in an interview with the principal and their teacher prior to registration. Parents are also required to present the student's complete immunization record and baptismal and/or official birth certificate. No child will be completely registered unless all of these documents are included with registration.

For current SJS students, forms will be sent home in the folders for the parents.

A registration fee of \$150 per student will be required. After the deadline of April 30<sup>th</sup>, the registration fee will be \$250. We encourage all parents of new and current students to register the students before April 30<sup>th</sup>.
