Masks are strongly encouraged for those who desire to come to Mass but have concerns regarding larger numbers of people. Hand sanitizer continues to be available and the sign of peace remains discontinued. The livestream will continue to be offered once each weekend for the time being.

Altar Servers Renewal and Training

With the slow move back to the much-hoped for normal...many of those who have assisted as Altar Servers in the past are a bit out of practice. And then there are those entering Fourth Grade that might be seriously considering getting involved with this important offering. So as to have a refresher and a training, we will have two mornings in June where the kids can get reacquainted with the guidelines and practices. Vivian Page has offered to assist with this training. No registration in advance--just show up. We need all of our existing servers to come so as to "brush up," and those who want to join the ranks of service at the Altar will receive training. A parent's email address is required at the training for the ministry scheduler program as well as indication of what Mass the family attends. The training will be **Wednesday, June 23rd** and **Thursday, June 24th** in the Church from 10 am to 12 pm. This is open to boys and girls entering Fourth Grade and up--and provides training for all Masses (English and Spanish).
