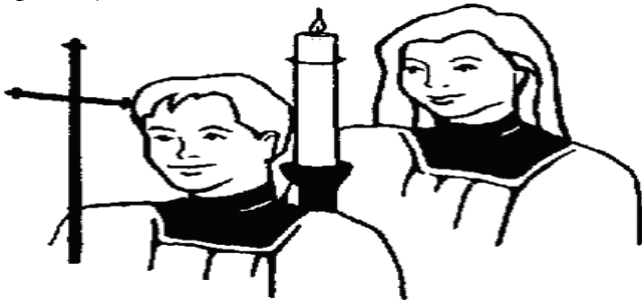

Altar Servers Renewal and Training

So as to have a refresher and a training, we will have two mornings in June where the kids can get reacquainted with the guidelines and practices.
