Diocesan Rosary Congress 2021: Immersing the Family in the Contemplation of Christ Our Peace

With the success of recent years of the Rosary Congress, Bishop Cahill has requested that we continue this prayerful tradition. Each hour there will be an individual in the presence of our Eucharistic Lord offering the rosary for special intentions. The intentions to be included in our prayers during this time:

- For peace throughout the world, especially peace in the Middle East; for an end to the conflicts in Iraq and Afghanistan; and for God's protection for all our military personnel, especially those serving overseas.
- For our families, that the Holy Spirit may give us wisdom and courage; that our homes may be safe "nests" where life is nurtured and cherished; and that we may be open to the forgiveness and mercy that flows from the heart of Jesus.
- For those who feel distanced from Jesus and feel "lost," that the Holy Spirit may give them hope; that we may have listening hearts and be instruments of healing; that the Church may be open and welcoming to all those in need.
- For the sins committed by our bishops and priests, that the Holy Spirit may bring healing to those who have been abused; that those who have committed grave sins may be led to conversion and accountability; that the Church may defend and proclaim the value of every human life.

Adoration Date Change

The feast of Our Lady of the Rosary [Our Lady of Victory] is Thursday, October 7th. This entails we move our monthly Eucharistic Adoration to **October 7th**. 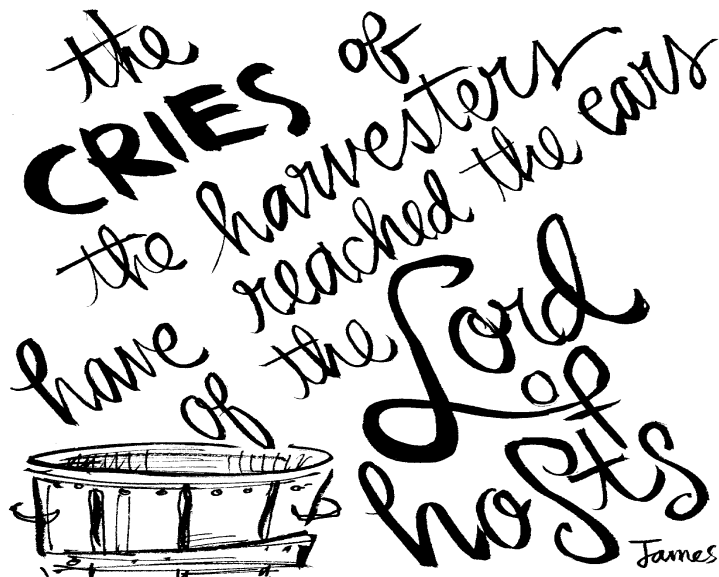

Top three male & female runners in each category & top three overall.

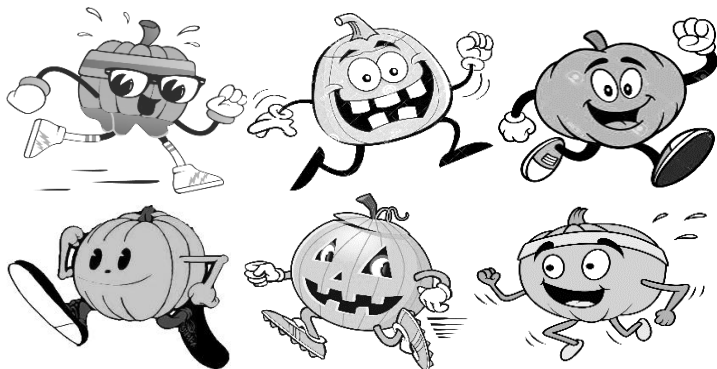
