Missionary Society of St. Paul

Our church is missionary by nature. Each of us as baptized Catholics are called to share in the work of evangelization. The diocese of Victoria collaborates with mission groups every year to raise fund for their missions through a program called the Missionary Cooperative Plan. The group assigned to our parish this year is the Missionary Society of St. Paul. **Fr. Evaristus Chukwu, MSP** will be speaking to us from the Missionary Society of St Paul this weekend, October 9-10. There will be a second collection to support them in their work.

The **Missionary Society of St. Paul (MSP)** is a congregation of priests founded in Nigeria in 1977. The Society now has 293 priests. They are working in eleven countries of Africa, (South Africa, Malawi, Botswana, Cameroon, Liberia, Chad, Central African Republic, The Gambia, Nigeria, Kenya and Southern Sudan), Grenada in the West Indies, the United States, England, Sweden and Ireland. They also have about 134 seminarians in their seminary in Nigeria.

Their mission in Malawi provides rehabilitation and support for over 360 orphans who lost their parents due to AIDS. They need our financial assistance to continue this mission. They also need funds to: 1) provide fresh water wells, and education in rural communities of Chad, Malawi, South Sudan, Kenya and Nigeria; 2) Sponsoring seminarians, our future priests; 3) Supporting priests in the founding/building of new churches. Your support to this worthy cause will be an immense encouragement to the Missionary Society of St. Paul to as they continue to take the good news to those desperately in need of it. May God bless you!

Sociedad Misionera de San Pablo

Nuestra iglesia católica es una iglesia misionera. Cada uno de nosotros, católicos bautizados, es llamado a participar en la obra de evangelización. La diócesis de Victoria colabora con grupos misioneros cada año para recaudar fondos para sus misiones, a través de un programa que se llama *missionary Cooperative plan*. El grupo asignado a nuestra iglesia este año se llama, La Sociedad Misionera de San Pablo de Nigeria. Padre Evaristo, MSP, de la Sociedad misionera de San Pablo va estar con nosotros el fin de semana de 9-10 de Octubre para compartir la historia de su trabajo misionero. Habrá una segunda colecta para apoyar su trabajo misionero.

La Sociedad Misionera de San Pablo es una congregación religiosa fundado en Nigeria en el año 1977 por Dominic Cardenal Ekandem y establecido por la conferencia de los obispos de Nigeria. El grupo ahora tiene 293 miembros sacerdotes, que trabajan en once países de África (Sur África, Malawi, Botswana, Cameroon, Liberia, Chad, Central African Republic, Gambia, Nigeria, Kenia, y Sur Sudan). También trabajan en las islas de Granada y Bahamas, y aquí en Estado Unidos, en Inglaterra, en Sweden, Irlanda, Italia, y en Canadá.

Su misión en Malawi da apoyo y ayuda en la rehabilitación de huérfanos quien perdieron sus padres por el SIDA. Tienen más que 360 huérfanos bajo su cuida. Ellos también dan de comer a los hambrientos, hacen pozos de agua y dan educación en las comunidades pobres de Chad, Malawi, Sur Sudan, Kenia y Nigeria. También apoyan a más que 134 seminaristas en su seminario en Nigeria además de proveer para sus sacerdotes involucrados en fundar y edificar nuevas comunidades cristianas e iglesias. Tu apoyo financiar a esta obra maravillosa será una tremenda fuente del ánimo para los misioneros de San Pablo mientras que sigan sembrando semillas de la fe alrededor del mundo. Gracias y que Dios te bendiga.



Planning Ahead: 2022

The opening of the 2022 calendar will be Monday, November 1st. Parishioners will be allowed to schedule **ONE Sunday Mass and ONE weekday Mass**. There is the possibility of combined intentions (where two families want a specific day - and they both agree to combining and then both intentions are listed). Even reducing the number to one each will still not open up the calendar greatly. So as to assist the number of weekends not being filled up so quickly--only ONE weekend Mass may be scheduled for a particular individual. Those who simply want to arrange for Masses (to be scheduled according to dates remaining open) may do so respecting a limit of ten. Near the end of 2022 those extra Masses not scheduled (due to lack of available dates) will be sent to the diocese where they are distributed to priests/parishes that do not have a surplus of intentions and where there are openings. This provides that Masses requested will be celebrated within a year. It's understood that this is not ideal--it's just dealing with the reality of everyone wanting weekends and finding ways to accommodate as many parishioner requests as possible. Recall that each weekend--of the four Masses--church law requires one Mass must be celebrated For the Parish Family. So, practically speaking, the parish has four weekend Masses (5pm, 7am, 9am, and 11am) and one of those four will always be set aside For the Parish Family.

Sanctuary Candle Intentions

As the new year calendar opens in November for Mass Intentions, the calendar will open for Sanctuary Candle Intentions as well. The offering covers the cost of the 51% beeswax candle that burns in the Church near the tabernacle. Just as we have a tradition of lighting vigil candles for special intentions, the sanctuary candle offering provides for the expense of this special candle that burns as a reminder Jesus is present in the tabernacle. A year allows for a possibility of approximately 52 weeks of Lamp Intentions. Again, with the limitation of time available and number of requests, the Sanctuary Candle Intention can be scheduled for **ONE** week for a particular person. To be noted is the reality that we actually have two sanctuary candles burning - one here and one at St. Ann. So as to allow more to utilize this much requested memorial - both candles will be available for sponsoring.

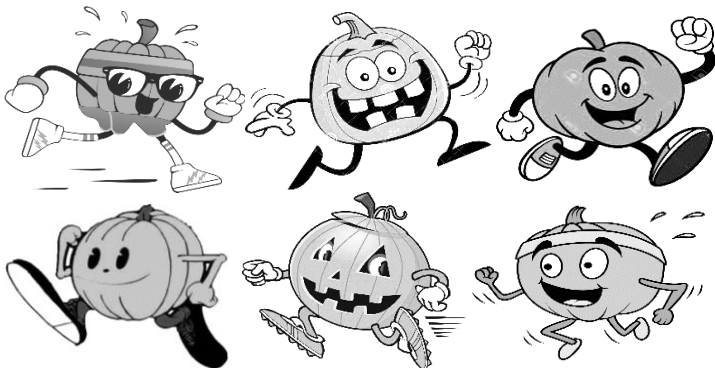
