Do	<p>Corporal Work of Mercy</p> 	<p>Seasonal – Oct. 4 is the feast day of St. Francis of Assisi. Do one of these activities in memory of him.</p> <p>Build a Church: It is said that when St. Francis first heard his call to religious life, he was told, “Rebuild my church.” He took this command literally, thinking he was to rebuild the church of San Damiano in Assisi. Thus, he began to do so, stone by stone. In honor of his obedience and hard work, gather as many rocks as you can find and then construct your own mini-churches. Get creative. Use twigs as a cross to decorate it. Build it outside in a garden or flower bed if you can and see if it lasts through the winter.</p> <p>Make a bird feeder: St. Francis is the patron saint of animals because he loved all animals and was said to even preach to the birds.
