Dear Parishioners.

Next Sunday, March 28, we celebrate Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord. This day begins Holy Week, the most important week of the Church's year. Especially important are Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter. These three days are called the Triduum because although they focus on different events, they are actually inseparable. I will write more about these days in this space next week, but today I am going to make a few comments about them. On Holy Thursday we remember the Last Supper, the first Eucharist. We only celebrate one Mass that day. The Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper. We will celebrate that Mass at 7PM at Sacred Heart. On Good Friday we remember the Lord's Passion. It is the only day of the year when no Mass is celebrated. There will be services of the Lord's Passion at 3PM at Sacred Heart, 3PM at St. Patrick's, 6PM at St. Joseph, and 7PM at St. Charles.
