## † A Note from Father Weisenberger †

Dear Parishioners,

We have begun Holy Week. In this space today I am going to make a few comments about the Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter. These are the most holy days of the Church's year. On Holy Thursday we remember the Lord's Supper and the First Mass. We give thanks for the gift of the Body and Blood of Christ in Holy Communion. The tabernacle is empty to remind us not to take this wonderful gift lightly. On Good Friday we remember Jesus' suffering and death on the cross. This is the only day of the year when we do not celebrate Mass. We do have Services of the Lord's Passion. On Holy Saturday Night we celebrate the Easter Vigil. This Vigil includes more readings than usual at Mass and also the blessing of the Easter Fire and a new Paschal candle. We would like to have the paschal candles from all the parishes in our pastorate present at the Vigil. If you are able and willing to carry your parish candle from the beginning of the Vigil until the end of the Exultet please let Ronnie Olvera know before 12 noon on Wednesday March 31<sup>st</sup> either by calling 884-1818 or @volvera@parish.dol-in.org. Most of us have probably kept vigil while someone was dying, the Easter Vigil is similar except we are keeping vigil to celebrate Christ's rising to new life. There are many other remarks I could make about these days. However, I will let these suffice for now. I hope that these most sacred days will deepen our appreciation for God's great love for us poured out on the cross.

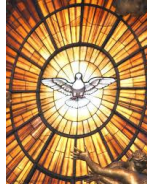

I am in the process of creating a list of all the **ministries** to meet with their leaders and present myself. I am also working on updating/creating a unified welcome packet. The web page will be updated, as well. And we are planning for a "Welcome Back to the Parish" event in the near future. We just have to work out the details. I will keep you posted!

In an effort to consolidate and make our communication more efficient, we are starting the process to also consolidate and update our mailing list for the entire Pastorate. We would like to make sure everyone is being informed about our exciting events!

I would like to be as much of service to you as possible. If there is anything you would like me to know about this community that will enhance our pastorate, please let me know. We are all in this together! This is our pastorate, and we all have different gifts that can make it better in so many different ways!

I will start working on updating Safe Environment records. You may receive a letter to renew.

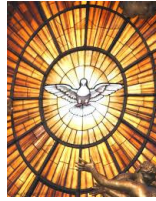

¡Hola!

¡Estoy muy emocionada de estar aquí y ser parte de este maravilloso equipo! ¡Estamos trabajando en tantas cosas emocionantes para que nuestra Pastoral sea la mejor posible! Me gustaría tomarme el tiempo para compartir con ustedes los elementos en los que estoy trabajando:

Con respecto a la **educación religiosa**, estamos tratando de ofrecer las clases en dos sitios separados en diferentes días, para que los padres puedan tener opciones. Busque la información de una encuesta para padres en el boletín del 4 de abril. También he aprendido que estamos teniendo más hispanos que se trasladan a nuestra Pastoral. Eso significa que también tenemos que pensar en ofrecer educación religiosa en español o bilingüe. Pero lo más probable es que eso suceda hasta el año siguiente. Sin embargo, todavía tenemos que empezar a trabajar en la formación de voluntarios para esos puestos. Por supuesto, todo eso depende del Espíritu Santo para inspirar a las personas a ser voluntarias, ¿verdad?

Estoy al tanto de la existencia de solo dos grupos étnicos en la Pastoral, hasta ahora: anglosajones e hispanos.
