Dear Parishioners of St. Patrick and St. Charles,

Greetings in Christ! ***I am excited to share with you that public weekend Masses will resume at our parishes on the weekend of May 30th/ 31st, the Feast of Pentecost.***

Bishop Doherty has given a dispensation from attending Sunday Mass through August 15. This means you are not obligated to attend Sunday Mass at this moment. For older adults and other medically vulnerable persons, we suggest for your safety and the safety of others, to please continue to stay home and pray along with Mass online. We plan to continue posting Masses on our website at least through the rest of the summer.

When public Masses resume, some things will be different for the foreseeable future, which means no returning to normal quite yet. There will be several procedures put in place (including social distancing in the church) in order to ensure the safety and health of all who are attending. In order to design and implement these procedures, we are asking that all parishioners complete a quick online survey.
