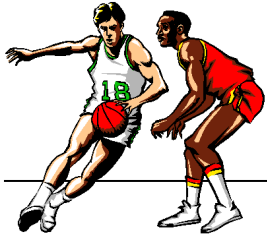

### What is the Purpose?

The purpose of the basketball camp is to enhance and teach the fundamentals of basketball. EACH ATHLETE WILL WORK TOGETHER WITH ATHLETES OF THEIR OWN AGE AND ABILITY.

### How much does the Basketball Camp Cost?

- **\$100 for Grades K-4** for 1 hour 30 min a day, 2 one week sessions of camp (includes t-shirt)
- **\$100 for Grades 5-9** for 1 hour and 30 min. a day, 2 one week sessions of camp (includes t-shirt)

### Option to Sign up for both Session 1 & 2

The option will be given to **3rd and 4th graders** to sign up and participate in both sessions. We offer this option to give our more experienced and skilled 3rd and 4th graders the opportunity to participate in our more advanced curriculum.

**Cost for both sessions will be \$125.**

### Basketball Curriculum

The curriculum focuses on the skill and fundamental development of individual players. The program is designed to improve the offensive skill and scoring ability of players.

#### **Areas of focus:**

- **Ball Handling-**The ability to get by a defender off the dribble, while maintaining speed, vision, and control.
- **Finishing Moves-**The ability to use body control and motion to score against contact.
- **Shooting-**We use a progression style of teaching to help build the perfect shot, both technically and mentally. We will be competing in organized shooting contests throughout the camp.
- **Leadership-** We have implemented a system of communication that has proven to produce leaders both in the sports world and beyond.
- **Games-** We will be competing in live, organized games throughout the 2 weeks of camp to enhance the athletes feel for the game.

\*Athletes attending Valders Area summer school are encouraged to bring a lunch or snack, as lunch will not be provided.
