"If you want to raise a child who is caring, organized, goal-oriented, and successful, you must provide a stable environment in which he can experience a childhood filled with both love and bonding experiences" says Dr. Gail Gross, human behavior, parenting and education expert. The Crossing has provided a stable environment for the past four years through The Crossing HOME, a program designed for single moms to belong to a community that will help create a new blueprint for navigating life. In the past four years we have seen thirteen women improve their emotional and spiritual health while learning parenting and relationship skills that are life giving. Eighteen children will grow up with a stronger sense of self and a strong central core because of the stable environment The Crossing has provided for them and their moms. We can't talk about the success of the home without talking about the women who have been committed to doing the hard work. We think of women like Liz and Ciara who birthed beautiful and healthy babies while finishing their college education, and moving on to starting their careers in their respective fields. We remember Dominique, who although intimidated by her debt, took a step towards freedom, responsibility, and committed herself to pay it off quickly and fully. We cherish the accomplishments of Mary, Cindy and Laura (among others) who have secured stable housing, childcare and full-time jobs. These women (and more to come) are providing homes for their children with less anxiety, more connection, and more bonding experiences that will give them (mother

From the Pastor's Desk

Happy Easter to everyone. Welcome back to all who feel safer in coming into the church again. It is good to see you in person. Even though many are coming again, just a word about the precautions that the Diocese of Green Bay has asked for the immediate time and a few changes in the Mass for now: namely, everyone is asked to keep a safe distance by using only the pews that are not restricted. You can share the same pew with others. Masks are still recommended when in a crowd within the church. In the church there are no books. However, if enough of you request them, I will order more. Small orders cost \$17.95 a piece. If enough requests, cost is about 50% less. These are your personal books and are not left in the church. Call the office if you are interested. In the Mass currently Holy Communion is only given out with the consecrated host and the sign of peace is omitted unless you only verbally greet others. I will keep you informed if there are any changes to these current practices. Nice to have you back to celebrate your love for God in the community of worshippers.
