## SACRAMENTS

**BAPTISM:** Please inform the parish 3 months before the birth of your child so that a Sacramental preparation may be scheduled. Thank you.

**RECONCILIATION:** 30 mins before Mass, Fri. 30mins after Mass; 15 minutes after last Sunday Mass; and by appt.

**MATRIMONY:** Please talk to Father 12 months before any desired date for this Sacrament so that the Sacramental classes may be scheduled. See wedding policy handbook on the website under Sacraments tab.

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK:** Please do not wait until you are on your death bed to be Anointed. Please plan ahead, if you are able, as the priest isn't always immediately available. If you are in doubt as to whether you should be Anointed, please contact Fr. Chris using the emergency number above.

**FUNERAL PLANNING:** Please schedule a time with Fr. Chris to plan your funeral, especially if your spouse or kids are not practicing the Catholic Faith. Please don't put that burden on your family while they are mourning your death.

## What does the Catechism say about...?

**“You Shall Love Your Neighbor as Yourself: The Tenth Commandment: You Shall not Covet your Neighbor's Possessions:**

**531. What is required and what is forbidden by the tenth commandment?**

This commandment, which completes the preceding commandment, requires an interior attitude of respect for the property of others and forbids *greed, unbridled covetousness* for the goods of others, and *envy* which is the sadness one experiences at the sight of another's goods and the immoderate desire to acquire them for oneself.

**532. What does Jesus call for in poverty of spirit?**

Jesus calls his disciples to prefer him to everything and everyone. Detachment from riches—in the spirit of evangelical poverty—and self-abandonment to divine providence free us from anxiety about the future and prepare us for the blessedness of the 'poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven' (Matthew 5:3).

**533. What is the greatest human desire?**

The greatest desire of the human person is to see God. 'I want to see God' is the cry of our whole being. We realize our true and full happiness in the vision and beatitude of the One who created us out of love and draws us to himself with infinite love. 'Whoever sees God has obtained all the goods of which he can conceive.' (St. Gregory of Nyssa)."
