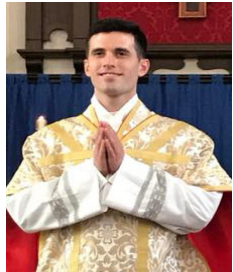

is a son of the Consortium with his home parish being St. Colman of Cloyne in Washington Court House.



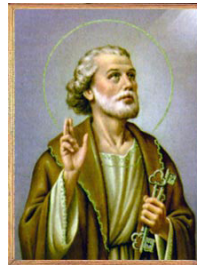

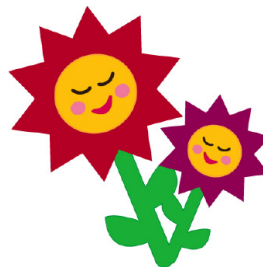
Novena for the success of Fr. Hartge’s pastorship!

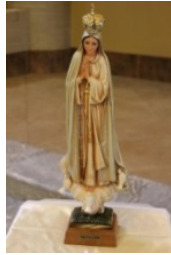

Presence to the Poor . . . Helping our St. Vincent de Paul Society with its mission is an excellent way to be a presence to the poor and to perform corporal works of mercy.

Feeding the hungry – donate items to the food pantry. Current needs are canned fruit, corn, and peas; pasta meals in pull top cans; pasta sauce; cereal; tuna; peanut butter; and soup.

Clothing the naked – when you donate items to Goodwill, ask for a Donation receipt and bring it to the St. Vincent de Paul Society. They are given credit for each bag of clothing given, which can be used to offset the cost of the vouchers they give to those in need of clothing.

Alms for the poor – This can be accomplished by several means available here at St. Peter's. Supporting the St. Vincent de Paul Society during its 5th Sunday Collections and using the monthly envelope. Support other local agencies such as the Assistance House, Love Inc., and the Good Samaritan Food Pantry with monetary donations.

PICK OF THE WEEK, June 10, 2018



Over the centuries, St. Anthony of Padua has been acclaimed as a great example of holiness through countless works of art, sculpture, and books. Many Catholics, and even non-Catholics, think of St. Anthony as the first one to turn to when something is lost. Yet amid this widespread veneration and devotion, we may miss the story of a man who began his life like all of us. This film reveals the journey of Fernando Martins de Bulhões, a thirteenth century Christian whom we know today as St. Anthony. Here, we discover a young man who was often "lost" and searching for direction in his life. He wanted to make a difference in the world of his time. As we encounter his humanity, we find someone with whom we can relate, someone who struggled in life, someone we could have easily called a friend. Shot on historic locations in Portugal and Italy, *Finding St. Anthony: A Story of Loss & Light* is a documentary film that focuses on the experiences of Fernando (Anthony) in his search for the life God is calling him to lead. And as we look closely at the journey of St. Anthony, what we find may surprise us: a reflection of ourselves. His story gives us insight and inspiration for our own spiritual journey.
